ROBBERY		
1/12/6 wsw-esw, r/o 625 -500 Main		Anonymous female phoned PSD and said she heard female calling for help & refused to ID herself. Officers were dispatched to scene. One officer said victim was not injured, but requested NYPD, 911 was notified. Victim unable to ID perp., he was wearing ski mask. Perp. snatched her purse that contained I-pod, cell phone, several credit cards, etc. Officers searched East/West sea walls, south & north sector, tram, etc. with negative results. RIHM Super Abdul assisted Sgt. with Eastwood cameras with negative results. ARREST - CRIMINAL POSSESSION MARIJUANA - RESIST. ARREST - While officer was canvassing area in search of perp. stopped a male running towards the tram, because he fit description of afore-mentioned; and attempted to question him. Male gave conflicting replies to question and fled; while carrying a plastic bag. Officer requested assistance, two officers responded and all gave chase. Defendant threw bag in bushes, arresting officer retrieved same, which contained US\$710. and 52 small zip-lock bags (approx. 16 oz.) of alleged marijuana. He was arrested, escorted to PSD, where he was "Mirandized" with two officers acting as witnesses and transported to 114 th Pct. for processing. Deputy and Captain notified.
1/16/6 4 fl. hall	560 Main St.	Male delivery man from China I, phoned PSD reported that five tall men wearing face masks had robbed him at scene of two/three orders amounting to US\$20.00 and US\$50.00 in cash. Officers searched scene for perps. with negative results. Victim said he had been struck on side of head, but refused EMS.
BURGLARY		
1/9/6 apt.	455 Main St.	ARREST Security Supervisor at scene phoned PSD, reported a possible burglary that had occurred during Sunday, Jan. 8 th during the day. Officers responded, met victim (Super/Bldg. Mgr.) and Security Supervisor. The former said he had boxes in hallway in front of his apt. which contained US\$6,000 to 7,000 worth of jewelry; it was in a small cherry wood box. Reporter stated when he reported for duty, he had seen a young man (later identified as the perp.) carrying a large number of CDs, which reporter took from him and escorted him out of bldg. However, reporter never contacted NYPD, PSD nor the Super. Several officers searched the island for perp. and apprehended him. One officer remained at scene. Daughter of victim stated she was missing some jewelry. When perp. was escorted to PSD, he was wearing a gold chain, which reporter identified. Subsequently perp. admitted to having been in bldg. and of taking property. Perp. was transported to 114 th Pct. and subsequently to Manhattan booking for processing. Reporting officer was to report to ADA on Jan. 9, 2006.

1/5/6 apt.	4 River Rd.	Resident's son-in-law phoned PSD, said unk. male youth entered apt., upon hearing door close. His mother in-law had been sleeping. The latter asked him who he was, youth stated the door was open and fled apt. Son in-law informed officer that apt. door was open awaiting a move-in. There were no injuries, nothing was taken.

1-2/6 sidewalk	510-540 Main	Officer responded to scene for garbage having been thrown about at scene. Sgt. responded, confirmed same; searched area with negative results. RIHM to be notified next day.
1/7/6 m/g 7-C	688 Main St.	While on patrol, officer was notified that unknown vehicle had struck her parked car (Burg. Camry.) Officer did see damage to driver's side front & broken headlight. Victim refused NYPD, she was late for appt. and would advise NYPD directly. Photo taken of ground.

1/13/6 hallway 625 Main St. Officer on patrol, checked West View lobby, resident reported broken window at scene; officer checked front of building, found glass on sidewalk. But no rocks, balls, etc. There were no people at scene. Super Jimenez was informed, removed glass, taped window.
