<b>ASSAULT</b> 10/3/6 r/o	579 Main St.	Officer was notified by person, who said there was a man bleeding from head wound at scene. Victim told officer he had borrowed money from a male resident some time ago and had not repaid him, because he did not have the funds. Perp. proceeded to beat him with victim's cane. Sgt. responded to scene and was aware of situation. NYPD responded, prepared report, called EMS/who responded, transported female to Mt. Sinai.
10/7/6 PSD	552 Main St.	ARREST Lt., Sgt. were at D.O.'s area when male perp. in-house with his wife. the male was using profanity and was repeatedly asked to calm down. Perp. refused and pushed the Sgt. on chest causing her to fall down causing bruises, severe pain from falling. Perp. resisted arrest. Injured Sgt. was transported to Mt. Sinai.

Counselor of Group Home said male perp. was sitting in bus when suddenly he assaulted female resident who was exiting from building, who sustained a cut on lip and other lacerations. Upon officers' arrival, male had been placed in bus and was off-island. The male was escorted to Lenox Hill by EMS. NYPD officer notified PSD officer that perp. would be arrested in the afternoon or on 10/13/6.
